Yes sir, I went out yesterday afternoon. Arrived on location approximately 1330 hrs. I did walk the site and followed the longest "finger" of the release. I was a dolt and did not grab my GPS out of my truck prior to my walk. So I am estimating the release stopped approx 1 mile from location. I was going to go back out there and get some GPS readings. We are going to need to clear the area for Arch. Do you want me to run that through my shop or are you going bring in a consultant to clear it? My preference is to clean up as best with can with minimal surface damage...
