Mr. Pair,

Per Mike Bratcher of the NMOCD, we need to install a monitor well at the former Maljamar Station in order to definitively determine the depth to water at the site and, thus, establish the correct remediation action level for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH). The NM Office of the State Engineer requires written permission from the landowner to issue a drilling permit. Basin Environmental, on behalf of Plains, hereby requests permission to install a monitor well at the site.

I plan to drill to a depth of approximately 150 feet. If we have not encountered groundwater by that point, the borehole will be plugged and abandoned. Otherwise, PVC casing will be installed to facilitate sample collection.

A "Proposed Monitor Well Location Map" is attached.
