Ben,

Your proposal for remediation of the former Plains Maljamar Station site is approved with the following conditions:

- Soils intended for onsite bio-remediation should be arranged in 6"-8" lifts, but no more than 12" lifts.
- Once bio-remediation cell/cells have been constructed, representative samples are to be
  obtained for laboratory analyses, to establish a baseline. A sampling schedule should then
  be established.
- Advise OCD once the placement of any liner has been determined.
- Sidewall sample analytical data is to be submitted to OCD for review in areas where excavation has been proposed to be limited due to roadways, or other limitations.
- Like approval by BLM.

OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations fail to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment.
