The OCD is assuming that the listing (50-99') is a typo. Please let me know if this assumption is incorrect. Like approval by BLM is required.

OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations fail to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
