COG Operating LLC would like to submit the enclosed document for closure of the above captioned well. The plan is in response to the C-141 Initial report dated October 28, 2015. Remediation work was completed under the workplan approved by Shelly Tucker of the BLM and Heather Patterson of the NMOCD District 2 on June 2, 2016.

All work has been completed in accordance with the approved work plan submitted to the NMOCD and BLM. Work included the excavation of the areas labeled S1 & S2 to 4' and a 6' excavation of the areas labeled S3 & S4. The backfill consisted of caliche and top soil. Top soil was brought in for the remaining 2' of backfill with the finished grade at approximately 6" above the surrounding landscape. Please see the attached diagram. The remediated area was seeded with BLM #1 seed mixture at the conclusion of the dirt work.

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
This release was caused when a poly flowline was hit by a vehicle and damaged. The line was shut in and vacuum trucks were dispatched but were unable to recover any fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The release is located in the pasture approximately 0.75 miles to the northeast of the well pad. The area of impact is approximately 225' x 150'. Remediation work was completed per the NMOCD/BLM approved work plan on June 6, 2016.
