Attached is El Paso Natural Gas Company's (EPNG) **FINAL** submittal of Form C-141, as NMOCD's required Written Notification, for the unauthorized release of hydrostatic test water in Dona Ana County, New Mexico. The event occurred during a hydrostatic pressure test of EPNG's existing 30-inch O.D. California First Loop Line (Line No. 1103) on June 11, 2016.

In conversations with Bradford Billings, NMOCD Santa Fe Office, I was informed that a final submittal of the Form C-141 was required. EPNG was asked for the analysis of a final soil sample from the affected soil at the rupture site. The soil analysis was forwarded to Mr. Billings for approval. In an email dated August 26, 2016, Mr. Billings stated that 'OCD is requiring no further action on this situation'. You will find Mr. Billings response included under Attachment D of the attached Form C-141.

EPNG is requesting closure of OCD's review of the inadvertent release of hydrostatic test water during EPNG's spike test of the existing L1103 located in Dona Ana County.
