This release was caused when the dump valve on the FWKO malfunctioned. Fluid was sent to flare as a result. A vacuum truck was dispatched to recover standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The spill impacted the pad and pasture around the flare. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
