Mr. Thomson,

Your proposal for remediation of the above referenced release is approved with the following conditions of approval:

- Federal sites will require like approval from BLM.
- It is OCD's understanding that the bio remediation will take place on the well pad and that no other surface disturbance will occur.
- Material for bio remediation is to be place in lifts not greater than 12 inches thick.
- Submit a proposal for methodology to be used to sample soils being remediated. Sampling is to take place at a minimum of 90 day intervals. After 180 days, OCD will review all analytical data and may require an alternative remediation plan if the bio remediation is not showing adequate progression.
- Sidewall samples are required to be obtained in a manner that will adequately define lateral extent of contamination in all directions.
- Notify the OCD District 2 office once remedial operations have been scheduled, and, prior to obtaining samples during the remediation phase.
