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BLM generally agrees with OCD's Conditions of Approval.

Please keep in mind that on BLM lands, initial/immediate excavation at pipeline leaks must be limited to the minimum needed to place a clamp on the pipe or replace a short 4-foot to 8-foot section of pipe. All disturbance connected with initial excavation must stay within the limits of the BLM Right-of-Way. Any further excavation requires written approval (or approval via email) in advance.

Enterprise's C-141 states: "Remediation actions will follow the Enterprise Products[''] General Release Notification, Response and Remediation Plan" (March 9, 2015). Please provide me with a copy of this document so that we can check whether it contradicts any BLM requirements.
