Thank you for the data. We are 1' closer to our goal, which is a **complete delineation**. Delineation means to show where contaminants clean up, or how far they have gone vertical and horizontal. When I said 1' increments, I should have added "until site is delineated". I just assumed that was a given. OCD will not consider a proposal until the site has been delineated to show where contaminants clean up to RRAL, or for chloride, 250 mg/kg, or to the maximum extent practicable. Your proposal for remediation of the above referenced release is <u>not</u> approved. OCD concurs with BLM assessment that the site lacks adequate lab data to consider this proposal. OCD requests impacted gravel in the battery be removed, the liner inspected for holes, tears, etc., and clean gravel replaced. In the event the liner has been compromised, OCD is to be notified. If the liner is intact, photos are encouraged for documentation. Impacted areas outside the lined battery area will require at a minimum, lab data from samples obtained at 1' increments. A remedial proposal may then be considered based on actual data.
