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

Approximately 50bbbls of crude oil were released into the lined containment. A vacuum truck was utilized to recover all of the fluid from the battery.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* All of the fluid was contained within the lined battery. A vacuum truck was utilized to recover the fluid from the battery. The stained gravel ballast was removed and disposed of. The liner was inspected and determined to be intact. New gravel ballast was installed in the battery.
