- It is OCD's understanding that the impacted area will be excavated to a total depth of 4' and that all excavated material will be, or has been, taken to an OCD approved disposal site.
- Representative confirmation samples are to be obtained from the sidewalls and floor of the excavation. More than one sample point at each will be required. Confirmation samples are to be lab tested for BTEX (8021), TPH (8015 EXTENDED RANGE), and Chloride, (300). OCD review of confirmation data is required prior to liner installation and backfill.
