I think that this revision captures what we discussed with you, Mike and Brad about 2 weeks ago. The "Generic CAP" provides background data and will be submitted with all CAPs forthcoming.

Shelly – the only difference between this surface remedy and those approved by BLM with eTech is

- 1. We use precipitation and storm water diverted to the spill footprint to flush the salt below the root zone
- 2. We do not use any additives other than some hay to increase the permeability of the soil
- 3. We provide as-built drawings of the remedy with relative elevations of berms, overflows, diversion channels, etc.
- 4. We take a second set of samples after 12 months **or** when volunteer vegetation is present
- 5. Seeding occurs after we observe the volunteer vegetation or sampling shows the soil is good for seeding.

Note the closure criteria does not rely upon chemistry – it is closed when the site is re-vegetated.
