RE: Part 34 Registration Extension Request - Terrapin Impoundment (2RF-104)

Mr. Bratcher:

Due to focusing on other acreage, Devon Energy's usage of the previously registered Terrapin impoundment (2RF-104) will be below the 20% throughput in 6 months threshold required by Part 34.13(C).

In compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) Part 34.13(C), Devon Energy is informing the NMOCD of the lack of throughput and requesting a 6 month extension to the impoundment registration. Devon has planned completions in the area scheduled to begin in August 2018 that will account for the 20% throughput required. We also have additional development planned starting in February 2019.
