Hello Mr. Herrygers,

Thank you for speaking with me this afternoon. Below are links to the Revised Spill Rule and updated C-141 forms. The area around 2RP-4730 has medium karst as well as 2 USGS wells that show depth to ground water to be less than 50 $^{\prime}$, therefore the spill should be remediated to the most protective standard that includes: Chlorides < 600 mg/kg and TPH < 100 mg/kg, these numbers will be found in Table 1 in the revised rule. Please also note that final samples must include all 4 constituents and any spill off pad should have the top 4 $^{\prime}$ be of non-waste containing, uncontaminated material so those samples should be at non-detect or the same as a background sample.
