Yesterday evening at approximately 7:14 pm, the Operator reported standing fluids in containment due to fluids exiting out of the enardo valve on the gun barrel tank. Approximately 80 barrels of oil was released and the majority was contained in lined tank containment. Approximately 8 barrels of oil released outside of the containment and affected the immediate area around the containment. Standing fluids have been recovered.
