Rebecca,

We have received your Workplan/Remediation Proposal for **2RP-5048 JP White #4**, thank you. This Workplan/Remediation proposal is approved under the following conditions:

1. All off pad areas to contain a minimum of 4 feet non-waste containing uncontaminated, earthen material with chloride concentrations less than 600 mg/kg. This may require additional sidewall samples and further delineation
2. Performing a grab sample plan of the remediation area, where each composite sample is not representative of more than 200 ft²
3. If rock refusal occurs, use a back-hoe/track-hoe to remove the rock. If the rock is immovable, use a hydrovac to clean the contaminated soil off of the rock surface and outline steps taken in the Closure Report.
4. Laboratory analyses of final sampling and a description of all remedial activities taken
5. Provide a scaled site and sampling diagram, photographs of the remediation site prior to backfill
6. All other closure reporting need to follow requirements set forth in 19.15.29.12 NMAC
7. Restoration, reclamation and re-vegetation to 19.15.29.13 NMAC
