Cliff,

Your permit/registration for the Leatherneck Recycle Facility is approved. Your request for a variance from the netting portion of the rule is approved. It is OCD's understanding that an audible bird deterrent will be utilized in lieu of netting. The OCD permit number for this facility is **2RF-142**. The earthen containment ID is **2RF-142-1**, and the above ground storage tank is **2RF-142-AST1**. Please refer to the permit number when submitting monthly C-148 volume reports or any other communication involving this facility. OCD is to be notified prior to any modifications and/or additions to the facility and/or fluid impoundments. All related documents will be imaged to the OCD's online file as soon as possible.

This facility will be located in a BLM mapped High Karst area. It is OCD's understanding that Matador has had an engineer certify as to the integrity and ability of the area to support the facility and related fluid storage impoundments.

The facility must be constructed, operated, maintained and closed per all aspects of [19.15.34 NMAC]
