Your request for an extension until 9/28/19 is not a problem. I would like to know where we are at to date. The initial report shows the release was in the unlined berm, on location and in the pasture. A request was made for KMZ or shape file of the release, in order for the BLM to assess the off pad portion of the release (to date we have not received this). On May 14th Sheldon indicated that they were conducting remediation activities at the site and that they would be conducting sampling in 48 hours. Your request for an extension states COG is currently conducting remediation at risk for this release. Could you provide a the KMZ or shape file showing the impact areas, a narrative as to what remediation has taken place, any results from the sampling and where you are heading with the remediation. If any questions, please get back to me.

Please find the attached C-141 for your consideration. Also, attached is the calculation sheet to determine the estimated release volume. The liquid lost estimate is based on the spill dimensions, estimated depth of fluid (wet soil depth) and type of formation. The spreadsheet will calculate the volume lost in the ground and does not include the recovered amount in the calculation. The calculated volume in the ground and the volume recovered were added together and reported on the C-141. If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me.
