Mattias,

I am currently assisting Victoria with some of the Part 36 review. A particular statement in the newspaper notice and landowner notice for both facilities, the North Ranch and South Ranch, drew my attention. It is here:

"Terracon conducted a subsurface investigation and groundwater was not encountered within 115-feet below the proposed lowest depth of the landfill indicating that fresh groundwater does not exist at the facility."

A quick look at groundwater depths at these facilities shows that groundwater at the North Facility is likely to be encountered at approximately 175'-200' bgs, as you listed in the notices. Groundwater at the South Facility may potentially be encountered at 140' bgs. I understand that, based on the actual boring information, groundwater will not be encountered at less than 100' bgs at both facilities, however, I believe the statement above could be somewhat misleading, in stating that "fresh groundwater does not exist at the facility." I do think it important to list the Terracon investigation in the notices. Please advise.
