Good morning Mr. Roybal,

Sorry I missed your call. If you are going to use another type of fence material, you have two options:

- To use "a four-foot fence that has at least our strands of barbed wire evenly spaced in the interval between one foot and four feet above ground level" 19.15.34.12D. (2) please submit form C-147 with the "Modification" box checked and a cover letter explaining the reason for the requested modification (this is not a variance).
- For the use of a fence different than that described in 19.15.34.12D.(2), that's a variance of the rule. Please submit form C-147 with the "Modification" box checked and a cover letter that includes:
 - ✤ a statement explaining the need for the variances,

- a written demonstration that the variance will provide equal or better protection of freshwater, public health and the environment
- If possible, a drawing or a schematic of the proposed fence.
