The OCD has approved the Site Characterization and Remediation Plan for incident # NRM1926958728 SD WE 24 FEDERAL P23 #001H @ 30-025-43318 1RP-5695 with the following conditions of approval:

• The entire release was off-pad. By rule 19.15.29.13.D(1): The reclamation must contain a minimum of four feet of non-waste containing, uncontaminated, earthen material with chloride concentrations less than 600 mg/kg and TPH less than 100 mg/kg. Surface to 4' below ground surface, sidewall samples need to comply with the strictest closure criteria limits in Table 1 "Closure Criteria for Soils Impacted by a Release" (less than 600 mg/kg for chloride).
