The OCD has denied the submitted Closure Report C-141 for incident # NAB1928851161 BISCUIT HILLS SWD #001 @ 30-015-28142 for the following reasons:

- The sampling protocol used in this remediation process was not previously approved by the Division and is not sufficient or adequate for this site. Only three confirmation composite samples were taken for a release spanning an area of approximately of 1685 square feet. Confirmation samples must be taken every 200 square feet per rule 19.15.29.12.D.(c). Operators may request a variance for any requirement of 19.15.29 NMAC. The variance request must include a detailed statement explaining the need for a variance and a detailed written demonstration that the variance will provide equal or better protection of fresh water, public health and the environment.
- Final confirmation sidewall samples should be 600 mg/kg or background for chlorides on and off pad, regardless of the depth to water. Surface to 4' below ground surface sidewall need to comply with the strictest closure criteria limits. The sidewall samples below 4' would revert back to Table 1 in the Spill Rule.
- The scaled final sampling diagram showing the three areas where the three composite samples and sidewall samples were taken, was not included in the report.
