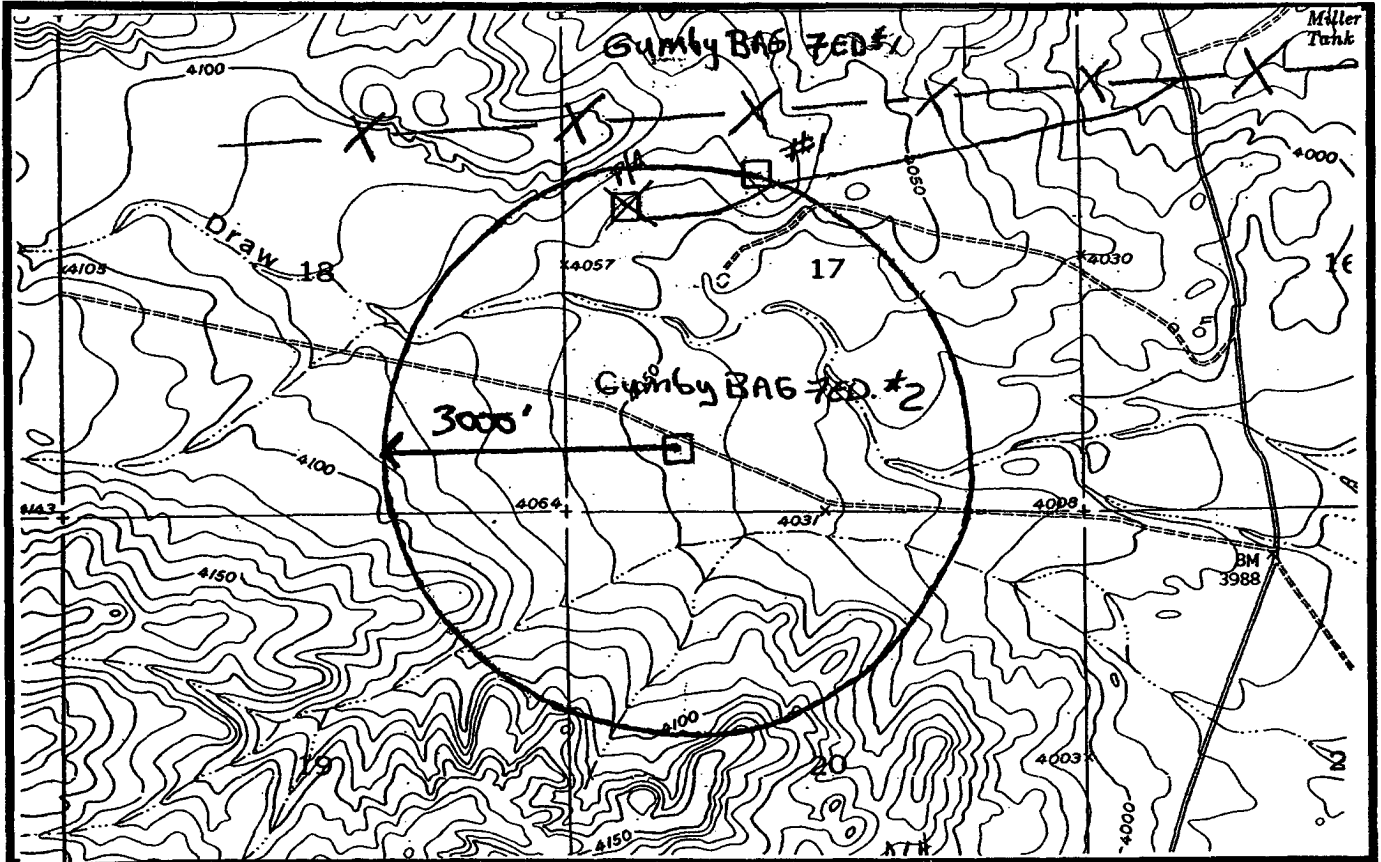
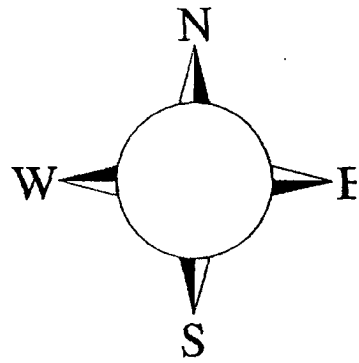

## Gumby BAG Federal #2 Location

This is an open drilling site. H<sub>2</sub>S monitoring equipment and emergency response equipment will be used within 500' of zones known to contain H<sub>2</sub>S, including warning signs, wind indicators and H<sub>2</sub>S monitor.



Assumed 100 ppm ROE = 3000  
100 ppm H<sub>2</sub>S concentration shall trigger an evacuation of the site
