In reference to the above, Samson Resources Company is to shut-in said well on Friday, April 11th 2003, unless information is received, for failure to comply with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's (NMOCD) Rules and Regulations. On March 21st, 2003 an unsuccessful request was made by phone for a series of subsequent reports after spud and a notarized well deviation report. A follow up call was made on April 2, 2003 additionally failing to bring any response. Please refer to NMOCD's Rule 1103, specifically Rule \( \frac{1}{1}03.D \), and Rule 111.3 for further clarification to this matter.
