In regards for the above captioned well, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) will require the following:

This is for EOG Resources, Inc. to submit the **complete set** of electric logs as required per NMOCD Rule 1105.A.

As you should be aware, your contractor Schumberger, ran a FMI, MSCT and TVD logs as this is a directionally drilled well. If there are any other additional electric logs, please submit as required per the rule.

In addition, the NMOCD **will not** honor your request for confidentiality of completion papers and logs as requested in your letter dated 3/11/05.

Please refer to NMOCD Rule 1105.C for more information on this matter

In addition your company seems to continually either disregard or not understand the requirements of these rules whenever EOG Resources, Inc. drills and completes a well, in the future please submit NMOCD Form C-104 (Request for Allowable and Authorization to Transport) directly to my attention for review and approval.

Finally your company is in violation with NMOCD Rule 1105.A in respect of submitting the above regulatory information in a timely manner, which reads in part: "within 20 days following the completion or re-completion of any well the operator shall file form C-105 with the Division.....

In addition, one copy of all electrical and radio-activity logs run in the well must be field with form C-105."
