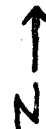

MASTER PIT CLOSURE PLAN
January 6, 2005

The method McKay Oil Corporation will be using to close our drilling pits is as follows:

1. Sample Pit Contents
2. Upon Approval of OCD, Dig and line trench with 12 mil cross woven plastic
3. Fold plastic over top
4. Place a 20 mil cap above
5. Cover with 3 ft of like surface material
6. Contour
