The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) District 2 Office has reviewed Murchison Oil & Gas, Inc.'s (Murchison) request, dated January 22, 2016, and submitted to OCD by your agent, R. T. Hicks Consultants Ltd. The submittal requests a variance to 19.15.17.11 F (2) [NMAC], which requires the side slopes of a drilling pit to be no steeper than two horizontal feet to one vertical foot (2H:1V). The variance request proposes to construct the entire pit for each of the two wells listed, utilizing a side slope of 1.5H:1V.

OCD does not agree that the proposed 1.5H:1V slope provides equal or better protection of Fresh Water, Public Health and the Environment, with the exception being the suction side of the fresh water portion of the drilling pits. Solids being discharged into the pits will place additional stress/weight on the liner and liner seams at the proposed steeper slope. OCD will approve the slope modification to 1.5H:1V for the suction side of the fresh water portion of the pits only, as was proposed in the original pit permits. At this time, your January 22, 2016 variance request is denied.

You have 10 days from receipt of this notice to request a hearing on the denial of your variance request. See 19.15.17.16 [NMAC] Please contact Florene Davidson at (505) 476-3458 within 10 days of receipt of this notice if you want to request a hearing on this denial.
