Please, consider this Chesapeake's request that we be allowed a variance to Rule #3162.7-5 paragraph 3 that states:

There shall be no by-pass piping around gas meters. Equipment which permits changing the orifice plate without bleeding the pressure off the gas meter run is not considered a bypass.

Currently Chesapeake has equipment in place that is used as a check meter only and has a by pass in order that we can change orifice plates without shutting the wells down or backing up the gas to the vent. Per the recommendation of Stan Mayo and Armando Lopez in the BLM office in Roswell, we will place a seal on the by-pass valve and will have our pumper keep a log of the seals.


