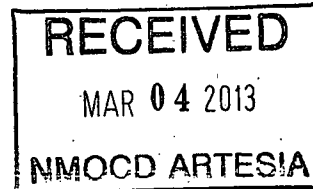

Your Application for Permit to Drill (APD), approved October 30, 2008, for the Letters 1525-20 Federal Well No. 2H, located SH: 1880 feet FNL and 208 feet FWL (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) sec. 21 and BH: 1942 feet FNL and 660 feet FWL (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) sec. 20, T. 15 S., R. 25 E., Chaves County, New Mexico, Federal lease NM-112249 has expired October 30, 2010 because drilling has not commenced within two years of the approval date.

If you wish to drill this well at a later date, please submit a complete application (1 original and 5 copies). Since the original APD has expired, the resubmitted APD will be subject to all of the processing requirements including the 30-day posting requirement. Please note on the resubmitted APD that it was previously approved and we will review the expired file for information which will expedite the processing.
