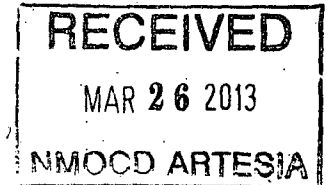

Gentlemen:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is in receipt of your Final Abandonment Notice dated August 09, 2012 for the Michael BBS Federal Com 1 well located 1,980' FNL & 660' FWL of section 3 T5S R 25 E. NMPM Chaves County, New Mexico.

On March 12, 2013, The well site was inspected and the well was placed in a two year monitoring pending satisfactory re-vegetative status. The BLM will re-inspect this location after a minimum of two growing seasons and when the site is determined to be in a safe, stable, and satisfactory re-vegetative state. The BLM will then process and approve your request for Final Abandonment. 43 CFR 3162.3-4 C.,C. states "...the surface of the lands disturbed in connection with the conduct of operations shall be reclaimed in accordance with a plan first approved or prescribed by the authorized officer."
