Operator,

Your work plan for remediation of contaminants at the above referenced well site has been received by the District 2 office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD).

The following stipulations apply to this project:

1. Samples are to be obtained from soils left in place prior to adding manure. Samples are to be tested at an OCD approved testing facility for TPH, BTEX and Chlorides.
2. Contaminated materials removed are to be hauled to an approved disposal facility.
3. Contact OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of remediation activities.
4. Contact OCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analysis of such samples are to be presented to the OCD.
5. Work on this project is to commence no later than November 6, 2005.

Be advised that acceptance of documents and/or remediation work plan proposals does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, acceptance of documents and/or work plan proposals does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, or local laws and/or regulations.
