Tony Tucker (Hudson Oil Company) met with Wesley Ingram (BLM) to discuss options; Hudson Oil Company was given verbal approval to proceed as follows:

Ran RCBL w/ 1100 psi on csg; found bad cement from 3505' to surface.

Performed injection rate test, pumped 280 bbls FW @ 6.6 BPM @ 2950 psi.

Set RBP @ 3563' & cmt retainer @ 3405'; squeezed w/ 150 sks Class C w/ .4% HALAD 322 (Dispersant, Fluid Loss & FR) 14.8 PPG 1.33 YLD & 50 sks Class C Neat 14.8 PPG & 1.33 YLD through perfs 3522' - 3530'.

SION

Tested squeeze to 2500 psi, squeeze held.

Drilled cement out, put well on production.

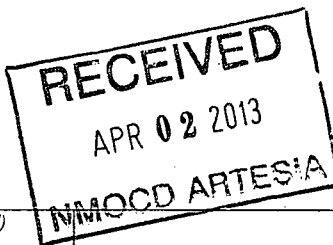
