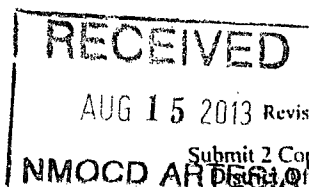

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Initially 20bbls of oil were released due to a closed equalizer valve. We were able to recover 18bbls of oil with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Contaminated gravel has been removed from the facility and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. Equipment and lining has been pressure washed. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
