


Initially 10bbls of produced water were released due to a hole that developed in the bottom of the drain line on the heater treater. We were able to recover 10bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the Falcon lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
