Your request for exceptions to the lesser prairie-chicken (LPC) stipulation has been determined to be outside the area where the LPC timing stipulation will apply for 2014 as identified in the BLM letter titled "Lesser Prairie-Chicken Timing Stipulation Map and Guidance for 2014." Your request does not require any further action for the timing part of the LPC stipulation or COA (restriction of activity in LPC habitat from March 1 to June 15, 2014) for drilling at this time. Any other stipulations or COAs attached to your APDs will still apply for the following locations described below.

This action is good for the 2014 LPC breeding season only. Your APD(s) are located within shinnery oak habitat, however these locations fall exterior the areas identified on the timing stipulation map and LPC have not been located within 1.5 miles of any of the locations requested. If new information is received or if LPC are found within 1.5 miles of a proposed location a contingency action will apply. The situation will be evaluated and analyzed by CFO wildlife biologists or other qualified BLM personnel to determine the appropriate course of action. This contingency could require that your company does accept a risk of shutdown of operations for the action or that the timing stipulation be reinstated on locations that have not been drilled at the time. Please be advised that the full stipulation will be enacted and become effective immediately upon the discovery of LPC within 1.5 miles of APD location. This process does not preclude attaching the LPC Stipulation to a lease or as a COA to an action.
