Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The cause of the release was a leak on the flowline. On 6/11/2014 a crew repaired the leak on the flowline, and a vacuum truck picked up approx. 2 barrels from the site. A one call was called in and further remedial action will take place once the one call is cleared.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area affected is approximately 90' X 75' pasture which is made up of sand dunes and mesquites. This area is located 520' south of the location by the lease road. Will perform the following tasks: Call in one call for the area affected. Then delineate the spill. Once the results of the samples are known we will get with BLM to take the appropriate steps to clean up the site.
