Location needs attention. Equipment OK. Pooled fluids at wellhead in cellar area. Some

contamination outside cellar boundaries.

Remediation is required. All soil remediation activities that occur on location must comply with the soil remediation guidelines in OCD publication "Guidelines For Remediation of Leaks, Spills,

and Releases". This document may be found on the NMOCD web site:

Notify NMOCD District 2 Office 24 hours prior to taking samples where results of the samples may be submitted to the OCD. Site remediation must be completed prior to January 10, 2006. Notify NMOCD District 2 Office when remediation on location is completed.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Divison Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.
