X 1. SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project will be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by ALL PERSONNEL, PERSONAL VEHICLES AND COMPANY EQUIPMENT. They will also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage or disturb cultural resources.

X 2. MONITORING IS REQUIRED:

X a. A copy of these stipulations to the archaeological monitor at least TWO (2) WORKING DAYS prior to the start of construction activities.

X b. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the archaeological monitor.

X c. The archaeological monitor will:

X 1. Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map(s)

X 2. Observe all surface disturbing activities within 100' feet of cultural site LA 121046

X 3. Other: _____

X 4. Submit a report of the monitoring activities within THIRTY (30) DAYS OF MONITORING unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. these stipulations must be attached to the report

X 3. THE GRANTEE MUST SELECT ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ALTERNATIVES:

 a. Controlled test excavations to determine if cultural resources are present:

X b. Reduction of the project size to avoid all significant cultural materials: location size reduced by 50' from north edge

 d. Preparation and implementation of a data recovery plan for cultural sites(s).

X 4. SITE BARRIER / FENCING:

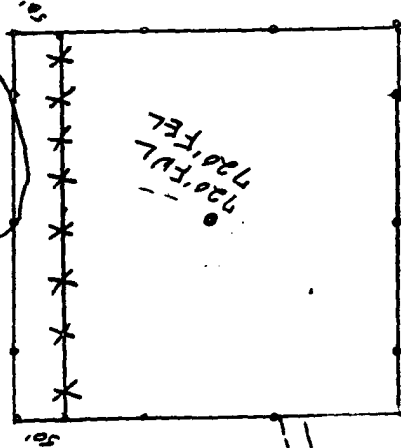
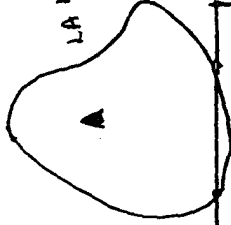
