

Mack Energy Corporation is requesting administrative approval from the NMOCD for approval of surface commingling of production on our Prince Rupert Federal Lease NMNM-131580 and our Seahawks Federal Lease NM-132677. Both Leases produce from the Round Tank; San Andres pool (52770) and will be commingled at a central tank battery located in the NWSE Sec. 19 T15S R29E. - 1. This agency will be notified of any change in your sales method or location of the sales meter.
- 2. This agency shall be notified of any spill or discharge as required by NTL-3A.
- 3. This agency reserves the right to modify or rescind approval whenever it determines continued use of the approved method may adversely affect the surface or subsurface environments.
- 4. This approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
- 5. Additional wells and/or leases require additional commingling approvals.
- 6. Contact the BLM Roswell Field Office at least 24 hours prior to the commencing any monthly well test.
