Dear Operator:

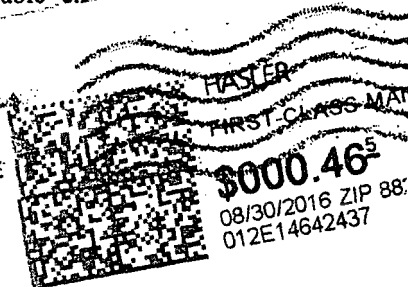
