We have determined that under existing conditions the Poker Lake No. 290 well is **not** capable of producing unitized substances from the Delaware and Bone Spring formations in unit paying quantities. The well was completed in the Delaware and Bone Spring formations on December 20, 2008. Production from the Delaware and Bone Spring formations shall be handled and reported on a lease basis retroactive to the date of first production (December 20, 2008). The well is located on Lease No. NMNM02860.
