Dear Mr. Armstrong:

We have determined that under existing conditions the Poker Lake Unit CVX BS No. 25H well is **not** capable of producing unitized substances from the Bone Spring Formation in unit paying quantities. The well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation on June 4, 2014. Since the well was determined to be a nonpaying unit well, a drilling and spacing unit must be established for the well so that a communitization agreement can be approved by the Carlsbad Field Office.
