Chevron respectfully proposes a 30' wide EDS easement network as a follow-up to the SND Jabberwocky 1H well located in Sec. 12, T24S-R31E APD (OMB # 1004-0137). The proposed EDS lines are to provide power to the Sand Dunes pads 1, 2, 3 and 4 wells, Section 12 CTB, Section 12 staging area and Ops yard, Section 12 fresh water pond and proposed Section 12 SWD facility. The total surveyed distance of this easement network is 12,902.11' (781.95 rods), estimated construction is sixty (60) days.

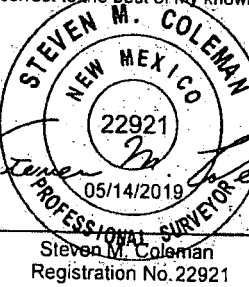
