



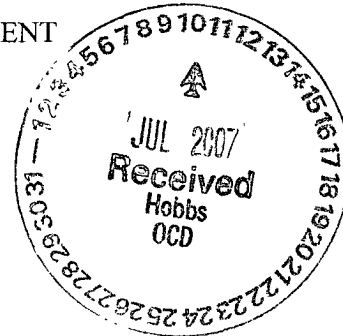

Ladies and Gentlemen:

On July 5, 2007, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned Poker Lake Unit well #91, located 360' FNL and 330' FWL in Section 12, T. 25 S., R. 30 E., Eddy County, New Mexico. As of this notice all final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location. The BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of this abandoned well site. All final abandonment requirements will have been met when the BLM is confident that the disturbed surfaces are capable of being restored to a condition similar to their original state.

Please submit a Final Abandonment Notice, Form 3160-5, original and five copies. The report should state that all reclamation work has been completed, and the location is ready for a final abandonment inspection.
