The impacted soils located near the flow line will be excavated and blended with nitrate fertilizer then placed in soil stock piles on location. Soil samples will be taken for analytical from the excavated impacted area & the soil stock piles. When analytical results reflect the TPH & B-tex to be under the RRAL for the site. A final C-141 form will be submitted to OCD requesting closure for the release that occurred on 9/1/2007.
