


All equipment will be inspected numerous times a day by each tour to make sure all equipment is operating correctly. Routine maintenance will be done to keep system running properly.

Methods of Handling Waste Materials

Drill cuttings shall be disposed of in steel cuttings bins (catch tanks) on the drilling pad (behind the steel mud tanks). The bins and cuttings shall be hauled to a division approved facility by an approved transporter. At the facility, the cuttings shall be removed from the bin and the bin shall be returned to the drilling site for reuse, moved to the next drilling site or returned to the provider.

Remaining drilling fluid shall be hauled off by approved transports to a division approved disposal facility. Water produced during completion shall be put in storage tanks and disposed of at a division approved facility. Oil and condensate produced shall be put in a storage tank and sold or put in a sales pipeline.

Reclamation

Within 60 days after drilling and completion of the well, the location area shall be reduced as determined by Operator to the minimum area necessary to safely and effectively operate the well. The reclaimed location area shall be substantially restored to the condition that existed prior to oil and gas operations.
