MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION Blast BLA Federal #1

1980' FSL & 1650' FEL Section 17-T26S-R27E Eddy County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

EXISTING ROADS:

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Exhibit A is a portion of the BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed well site is located approximately 25 miles Southeast of Malaga, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS: Go south Malaga, NM on highway 285 for approximately 10.7 miles to Whites City Road (CR-724). Turn right here and go approximately 7.5 miles. At this point there will be a lease road going south. Turn south here and go approximately .4 of a mile to the Hay B Federal #1 well location. The new road will start at the southeast corner of the Hay B Federal #1 location going in a southeasterly direction for approximately 1.5 miles to the southeast corner of the proposed Blast BLA Federal #1 well location.

PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 1.9 miles in length from the point of origin to the southeast corner of the drilling pad.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on one sides. Traffic turnouts will be constructed as needed.
- D. The route of the road is visible.
- E. Existing roads will be maintained in the same or better condition.

LOCATION OF EXISTING WELL:

- A. There is no drilling activity within a one-mile radius of the well site.
- B. Exhibit D shows existing wells within a one-mile radius of the proposed well site.

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:

- A. There are no production facilities on this lease at the present time.
- B. In the event that the well is productive, the necessary production facilities will be installed on the drilling pad. If the well is productive oil, a gas or diesel self-contained unit will be used to provide the necessary power. No power will be required if the well is a producing gas well.
