BLM Remarks, continued

CALICHE: Strip off caliche from pad and 4080 feet of access road. Caliche can be used to build other roads or pads, or it can be hauled back to a nearby caliche pit.

CELLAR.

Backfill cellar.

RESTORE NATIVE CONTOUR AND TOPSOILS:

Restore pad and access road to natural contours and topsoils similar to surrounding pastures

Rip final recontour of pad, access road, and other trespass roads associated with location perpendicular to downslope drainage. Any large boulders pulled up during the ripping process need to be reburied on location

EROSION CONTROL

Install windrows and/or erosion berms across location and reclaimed roads to protect reclaimed location from loss of topsoils due to wind scouring or water erosion.

Seed the location with BLM seed mixture, combination #3 and #4. BLM may wish to inspect final dirt work prior to removal of reclamation equipment and to witness the seeding process Contact Terry Gregston three days prior to removal of heavy equipment from location and three days prior to seeding: (575) 234-5958.

PROTECTION OF FINAL RECLAMATION WORK

Once all the reclamation of the site is completed and approved by BLM, reclaimed surface areas must be protected from trespass traffic by fencing and/or berming access to the reclaimed areas. The berm and fencing should should be high enough and long enough to barricade the reclaimed area from trespass traffic. Do not leave pullouts large enough for vehicles to park between the main lease road and the berm. Fencing may also be required in addition to the berm to ensure trespass traffic does not drive around the berm.
