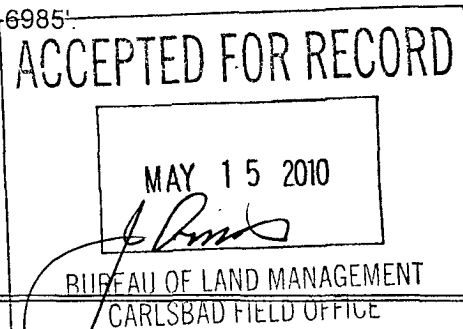

2/28/10 Began recompleat procedures. Pumped 70 bbls down casing. Did not load. Pumped 50 bbls down tubing. Released packer. NU BOP. Set a 5-1/2" 10K CIBP at 9504' with 35' cement on top.

3/1/10 Tested casing to 1500 psi, held good for 15 min.

3/3/10 Perforated Wolfcamp 6960'-6984' (25). AS-1 packer and 2-7/8" tubing at 6985'.

4/16/10 Date of 1st production for recompleat - Wolfcamp
